

If a student in grades 7 through 12 is absent from a class more than 10% of the days in one semester, credit in that class may be withheld by the school.

The principal of each secondary school shall set up an advisory committee of teachers to study each such case before the credit is withheld. If circumstances surrounding the absences should warrant, the committee may recommend that the rule withholding credit should be waived.
