

The board of trustees shall have authority to establish a system of fees to be charged to students to cover the cost of consumable materials used by the student for creation of learning projects of intrinsic value which become the property of the student. The board of trustees shall also have the authority to establish a system of deposits, or charge to cover excessive wear and tear, damage or loss of instructional materials or equipment used by the students or district employees.
